

ICUAS'19 PRIVACY POLICY

This Statement of Privacy applies to the <http://www.uasconferences.com> website used for the 2019 International Conference on Unmanned Aircraft Systems (ICUAS'19), which is financially sponsored by ICUAS Association, Inc., and governs data collection and usage. By using this website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

Collection of your Personal Information

ICUAS'19 may collect personally identifiable information, such as your e-mail address, name, home or work address or telephone number. If you register online for the conference you agree to terms and policy provided by <https://controls.papercept.net>. If you register directly through ICUAS, ICUAS may collect and store billing and credit card information. However, this information will not be used for any other purpose, nor leased, rented or distributed to other parties. Such information will ONLY be used for registration purposes processing the registration fees for ICUAS'19.

Information about your computer hardware and/or software also may be automatically collected by the ICUAS conference websites, that is, www.uasconferences.com, www.uasconferences.org, www.uasconferences.net, www.uasconferences.info. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring website addresses. This information is used ONLY for ICUAS'19 to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of this website.
